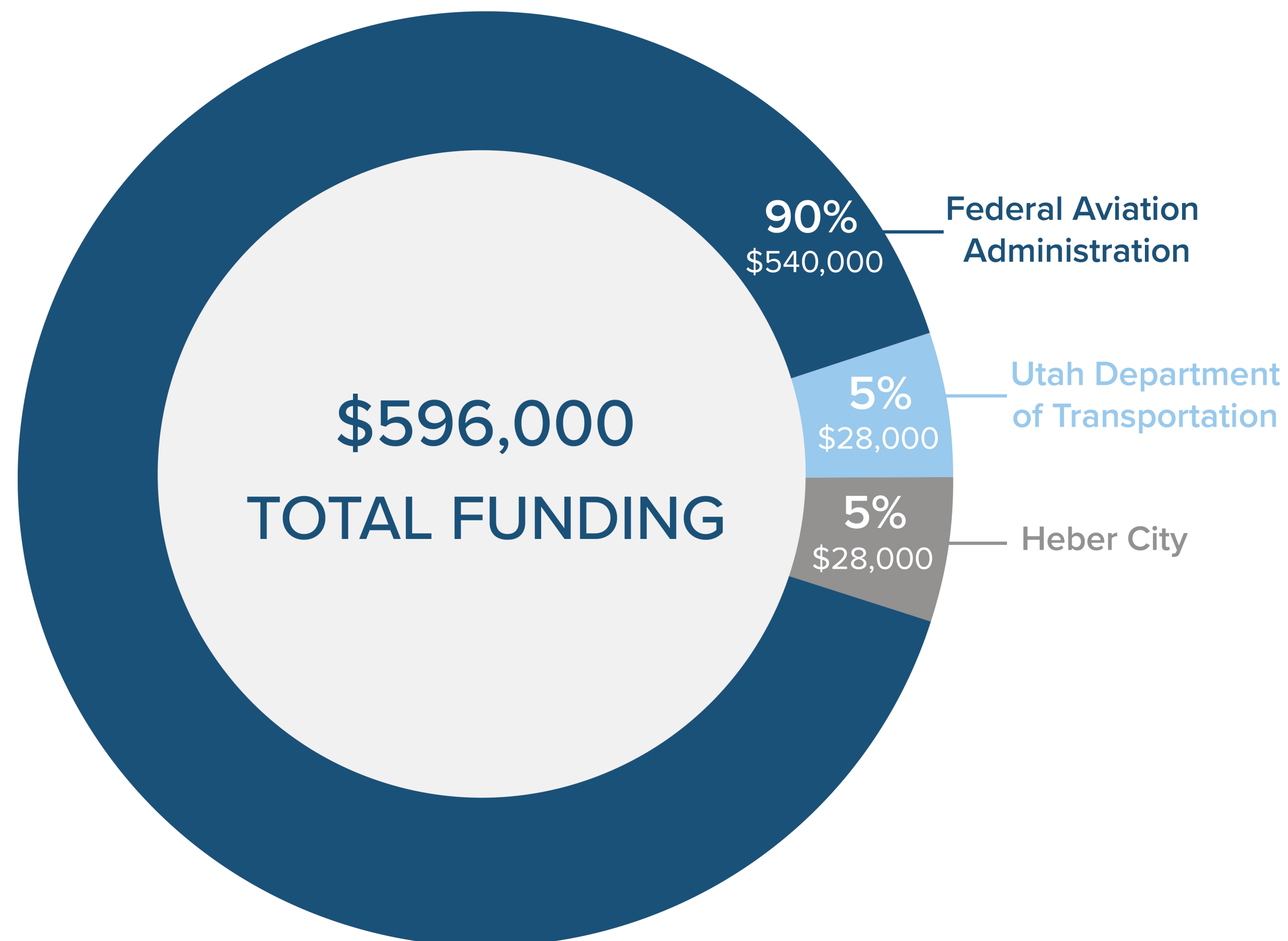




FUNDING

The Heber Valley Airport and its improvement projects are paid for by the federal, state, and local governments. Additionally, the airport earns revenue from landing fees, leases, and fuel charges.

Airport Master Plan Funding



Federal Aviation Administration

\$540,000

The FAA's Airport Improvement Program (AIP) is funded by airport users across the country and pays for 90% of the improvement projects at Heber Valley Airport, including the Airport Master Plan update.



Utah Department of Transportation

\$28,000

UDOT supports airports across the state by matching the airport's contributions to an improvement project.



Heber City

\$28,000

The City and airport pay for 5% of improvements, which are entirely funded for by airport revenues.
